

## WHAT'S INVOLVED

---

The LIGHT programs vary in length and are designed to equip today's youth with the skills and abilities to share tomorrow's hope with others. Participants will have many opportunities in a variety of leadership experiences and will be challenged in all areas of their lives. All **three levels of the program consist of the following components: leadership training; service; and camp ministry.** Upon completion of all three phases of the program, a reference letter will be written for future employers and a certificate will be presented.

## REQUIREMENTS

---

- spiritual**- the desire to grow spiritually and serve Christ.
- attitude** - motivated to learn, improve and cooperate with others.
- physical**- stamina to cope with camp program and perform at your best.
- age**           LIGHT 1: going into Grade 10 or older  
                    LIGHT 2: going into Grade 11 or older  
                    LIGHT 3: going into Grade 12 or older
- program**- to be accepted into the next level, you must have completed the level before.  
(special exceptions are sometimes made at the discretion of the LIGHT Director)

## HOW DO I APPLY?

---

- Complete the application in full and mail it with your program fee to:

- We do not accept faxed applications.
- Application deadline: March 31<sup>st</sup>  
After that applications will be received until the programs are full. There are limited spots in each program so apply early to avoid disappointment.

## DETAILS and DATES

---

### LIGHT 1: S.I.T. (Staff in Training)

Details: This 3 week program is set up to give the participant a full understanding of the commitment, effort and energy that goes into being a Tulahead staff member. Time will be spent in daily sessions, working with the kitchen dish crew, and spending time with the campers. After completing LIGHT 1 the participants are invited back to experience camp as a camper as they enjoy a week at **Sr. High camp at half the regular price!** (extras not included)

Dates: July 4-24 and August 1-21

On the application form please check your first choice, but note that there are no guarantees that you will be enrolled in your first choice. Once the application process is completed the participants will be put into groups best suited for the program.

### LIGHT 2: L.I.T. (Leaders in Training)

Details: This 2 week program is set up to give the participants a hands-on experience as group leaders and assistant activity instructors. The sessions will focus mostly on how to be a leader - physically, mentally and spiritually. Lots of opportunity will be given to be hands-on with the campers and work with the summer staff in different program areas.

Dates: July 4-17 and August 1-14

On the application form please check your first choice, but note that there are no guarantees that you will be enrolled in your first choice. Once the application process is completed the participants will be put into groups best suited for the program.

### LIGHT 3: C.I.T. (Counsellors in Training)

Details: This 2 week program will involve sessions about counseling, opportunities to observe various counselors in action, and an opportunity to put everything into action as you join a cabin and assist the lead counselor with their daily duties.

Dates: August 1-14

## PROGRAM FEES

---

### Costs:

LIGHT 1	\$330(program) + \$45(fun day activities) = \$375
LIGHT 2	\$220(program) + \$45(fun day activities) = \$265
LIGHT 3	\$220(program) + \$45(fun day activities) = \$265

Program fees cover the applicant's food and lodging while at camp, a program tshirt and binder and the leaders wages.

The only other money that applicants would need to bring to camp would be laundry money (\$3/load) and money for the general store if they wish to spend any money there.
